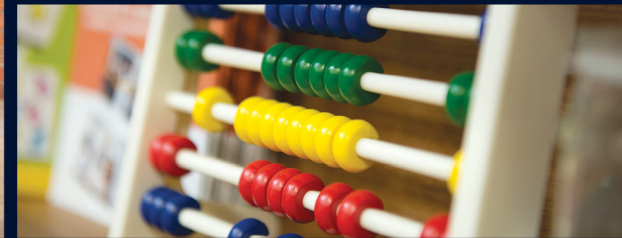
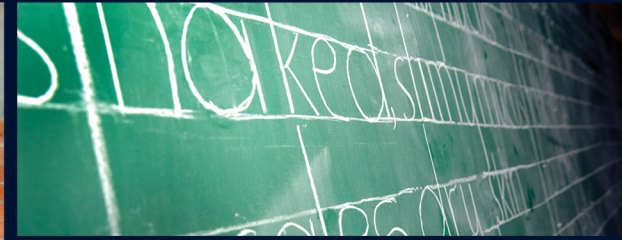

FOUNDATION PHASE TEACHER

The Foundation Phase (FP) is a critical phase in the education of children. It lays the foundation and building blocks upon which learning can take place. Foundation Phase teachers are responsible for the educational foundation of children between the ages of five and nine (Grade R to Grade 3). How and what they teach profoundly influences the rest of these children's lives.

HOW TO CALCULATE APPLICANT SCORE

- ❖ **APPLICANT SCORE (AS)** replaces **ADMISSION POINT SCORE (APS)**;
- ❖ **Percentages** and not levels (1-8) are used to calculate the Applicant Score;
- ❖ **Life Orientation is not included** in the calculation of the Applicant Score;
- ❖ Applicants must meet **direct entry requirements** (AS + subjects and % required);
- ❖ In addition, for those **applicants from quintile 1,2 or 3 schools** who attain 50% or higher for Life Orientation, **7 points may be added** to their score out of 600 to arrive at their final AS.
- ❖ **Testing** as an alternative admission route is no longer offered.
