Students must have an undergraduate DEGREE to enrol for a PGCE.



Admission Requirements for the PGCE

- The minimum entry requirement is an approved undergraduate Bachelor's degree obtained with a 60% average.
- PGCE (FET) To specialise in two FET school subjects, the basic Bachelors qualification should include at least two school approved specialisation subjects at third year level (NQF 7).
- PGCE (SP-FET) To specialise in one SP subject and one FET subject, the basic Bachelors qualification should include at least one school approved specialisation subject at third year level (NQF 7) and one school approved subject at second year level.

Admission Requirements for the PGCE

 Applicants may only choose method combinations within the subject streams specified in the table below.

Subject Specialisation requirements:

- English Home Language—Applicants must have English literature modules up to third year level
- Life Orientation Applicants must have obtained a minimum average of 60% for Psychology modules completed in their undergraduate qualification
- Economic Management Science Applicants must have obtained a minimum average of 60% for the commerce modules completed in their undergraduate qualification (Accounting, Business Studies, Economics)
